UAE Ready to Strengthen Links with Cuba



Abu Dhabi, February 25 (RHC-PL) — Furthermore, the United Arab Emirates (UAE) and Cuba on Tuesday expressed willingness to take concrete and immediate steps to strengthen and expand cooperation in various fields, diplomatic sources highlighted in Abu Dhabi.

The commitment was made during a meeting between the Deputy Minister of the United Arab Emirates for Political Affairs, Ahmed Al Jarman and Cuban diplomat Enrique Enriquez.

Cuba and the UAE, a Federation made up of seven small Emirates of the Arabic peninsula, established diplomatic relations on March 18, 2002.
