Head of EU Foreign Affairs Pays Official Visit to Cuba

Havana, Mar 23, (RHC), — The High Representative of the Union for Foreign Affairs and Security Policy Federica Mogherini is paying an official visit to Cuba on March 23 and 24.

Mogherini is scheduled to hold official talks with Cuban foreign minister Bruno Rodriguez and meet an agenda that also includes meeting with other local authorities.

The visit takes place as the European Union and Cuba hold negotiations towards a political and cooperation accord, reads a statement recently issued by the European Foreign Affairs Service.

"The European Union has closely followed developments in Cuba and its relations with key international actors, which favors a new dynamic in the region and in Cuba itself, offering new opportunities for all," reads the statement.

The European Union and Cuba started negotiations for a first bilateral accord in April 2014 and in March 4 and 5 this year, they held the third round of negotiations
