Terrorist Groups Steal Thousands of Syrian Antiquities in Idleb



Damascus, Apr 7, (RHC), -- Mamun Abdolkarim, director of Archaeological and Cultural Monuments of Syria, has recently denounced that some 15,000 antiquities are in danger of being sold on the black market by terrorist groups occupying the city of *Idleb*.

Addolkarim raised the alarm, following the reported occupation of the city of *Idleb* by terrorists of the *Al-Nusra* Front and the Islamic State (IS), who are vandalizing the cultural heritage of the city.
