

Cuba's “Conducta” Wins Grand Prize at Film Festival in Japan



Tokyo, July 28 (RHC) — “*Conducta*” by Cuban director **Ernesto Daranas Serrano** took the grand prize at the Skip City D-Cinema festival on Sunday in Japan.

Set in Havana, *Conducta* or *Behavior in English*, follows the story of an 11-year-old boy named Chala who survives by training pit bulls to take care of his drug addicted mother.

The film fest closed July 26th after its nine-day run in the city of Kawaguchi, north of Tokyo.
