

Cuban Communist Party Holds Local Meetings Prior to National Congress



Havana, September 14 (RHC)-- Cuban Communist Party members held the first 27 municipal meetings, which along with provincial gatherings, started a process towards the 7th Congress of the political organization, slated for April 15th and 16th next year.
