Cuban Movie Lovers Delighted with Latin American Film Festival



The 35th International Latin American Film Festival got underway in Havana with the screening of the Chilean movie Gloria, which has received both critics' and audiences' acclaim worldwide.

From November 5th through 15th movie lovers, filmmakers and experts are scheduled to enjoy the screening of over 400 films, 198 of which are competing for the coveted Coral Awards.

Havana's Latin American Film Festival is one of the most prestigious events of its kind in the region, and will be dedicated, among others, to festival founder, Alfredo Guevara, who passed away this year.
