Greeks Stage Protests Against Saudi Execution of Nimr



Athens, January 7 (RHC)-- People have taken to the streets of the capital of Greece against Saudi Arabia's recent execution of a prominent Shia clergyman.

"We ask Saudi Arabia to stop 'investing' in terrorism. We ask Saudi Arabia to stop nurturing extremists and fanatics and let them kill simple Muslims," said Ashir Haider, a representative of the Shia Muslim Community of Greece, who was among those attending the rally in Athens.
