

Haitian President Agrees to Transitional Government



Port-au-Prince, February 6 (RHC-tel) — President Michel Martelly, whose term ends on Feb. 7, has agreed to a transitional government. Under the terms of the agreement, president Martelly will remain in office until after the election. After signing the pact, the leader of the country's main opposition party said. The text of the agreement is clear and precise. A bicameral commission will then decide on the new constitution. The country's electoral council will also be reformed.
