

U.S. Government Shutdown Could Go on Indefinitely



Washington, October 3 (RHC)-- U.S. President Barack Obama and congressional leaders emerged far from a deal that could reopen the federal government after talks at a White House meeting.

President Obama called for a meeting with Senate Majority Leader Harry Reid, Senate Minority Leader Mitch McConnell, House Speaker John Boehner, and House Minority Leader Nancy Pelosi to discuss ways out of the government's budget stalemate as the first U.S. government shutdown in 17 years entered its third day on Thursday.
