Health Minister Says No Cases of Zika, Chikungunya nor Yellow Fever Reported in Cuba to Date



Havana, February 17 (RHC)-- Health Minister Roberto Morales Ojeda said that no cases of Zika, Chikungunya nor yellow fever have been reported in Cuba to date, February 17th.
