Fidel Castro Attends Closing of Communist Party Congress



Havana, April 19 (RHC)—The historic leader of the Cuban Revolution, Fidel Castro, attended the closing Tuesday of the 7th Congress of the Communist Party of Cuba, in which nearly 1,000 delegates and 280 guests participated.

Speaking during the closing plenary session, Fidel addressed the Congress and said this would probably be his last address from that stage.
