

Congratulatory Messages Continue to Arrive for Anniversary of Moncada Attack



Havana, July 27 (RHC)-- Congratulatory messages continue to come in for the 63rd anniversary of the assault on the Moncada and Carlos Manuel de Céspedes barracks -- commemorated yesterday, July 26th.

Cuba received messages of solidarity from Nicaraguan President Daniel Ortega and Venezuelan President Nicolas Maduro.

Media sources in Mexico highlighted today the celebration ceremony held in the central Cuban province of Sancti Spiritus, presided over by President Raul Castro.

Digital versions of La Jornada and Excelsior newspapers have published news stories related to the commemoration.
