Anti-Trump Protesters Rally in Washington, DC



Washington, August 29 (RHC)-- Hundreds of U.S. activists have gathered outside one of Donald Trump's projects in Washington, DC to express their opposition to the Republican presidential nominee. The gathering, which was held at Trump International Hotel's building site on Sunday, condemned Trump's racist and insensitive rhetoric.
