

Leaked E-mails Show Hillary Clinton Campaign Struggling to Address Sanders's Popularity



Washington, October 17 (RHC)-- Another batch of newly leaked e-mails show how Hillary Clinton's campaign struggled to deal with Vermont Senator Bernie Sanders's popularity during the primary season.

The e-mails, released by WikiLeaks, appear to come from the account of Clinton campaign chairperson John Podesta. In one e-mail, an adviser wrote to Podesta: "Message needs to be more positive, upbeat, hopeful. ... Bernie is saying we can change the world. Her msg is 'No, we can't' because ..."

The aide recommended Clinton's campaign feature more young people in her campaign ads. Another e-mail also shows Clinton aide Doug Band calling Clinton's daughter, Chelsea, a "spoiled brat." This is the second batch of Clinton campaign e-mails released by WikiLeaks in the last four days... with thousands of e-mails to come.
