Permanent Commissions of Cuban Parliament Analyse Electoral Approach



Havana, July 8 (RHC), -- From Monday, the permanent committees of the National Assembly of People's Power will begin their discussions prior to the ninth regular session in the eighth legislature of the Cuban Parliament.
