

Mozambique Expresses Appreciation for Cuban Cooperation



Havana, December 13 (RHC) The president of Mozambique, Felipe Nyusi, has expressed the interest of his Government to increase collaboration with Cuba in the fields of health, education, agriculture, tourism and culture.
