Armando Morales: National Theater Award Laureate for 2018



Cuba's Theater Award has been granted to puppeteer, painter, designer, actor and artistic director, Armando Morales, for his more-than-35-year contribution to Cuban stages.

Morales is one of the founding members of the National Puppet Theater along with the Camejo brothers and other performers. He has taken his art to important groups and theaters in the Americas, Europe and Africa; he is a professor of the Cuban Arts University.
