Sri Lankan foreign minister meets with Cuban lawmakers



Havana, June 28 (RHC)-- Sri Lanka's Foreign Minister, Vasantha Senanayake, who is on an official visit in Cuba, was received on Thursday by the president of the International Relations Commission of the National Assembly of Popular Power, Yolanda Ferrer.
