

Havana Provincial Assembly holds solemn session to celebrate 500th anniversary



Havana, November 16 (RHC)—The provincial Assembly of People's Power in Havana held a solemn session Saturday to celebrate the 500th anniversary of the Cuban capital.

Army General, Raúl Castro Ruz, First Secretary of the Communist Party of Cuba, the President of the Republic, Miguel Díaz-Canel Bermúdez, and other top authorities of the national government attended the ceremony which took place at the García Lorca Hall of the Alicia Alonso Grand Theater.

In delivering the key-note address, the president of the provincial government, Reynaldo García, acknowledged those who spared no efforts to complete the numerous actions undertaken to bring the best of the city on its anniversary.
