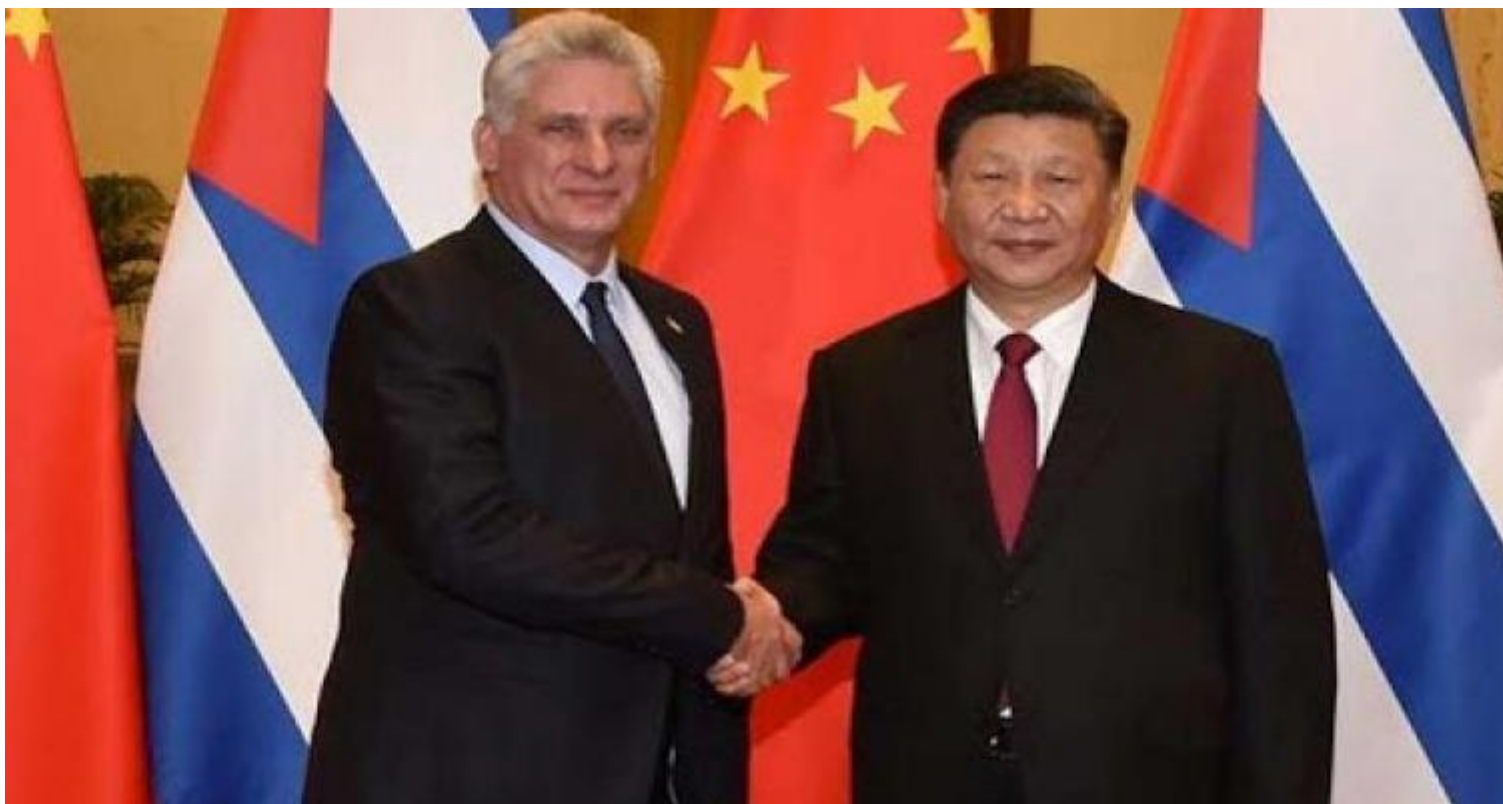


Díaz-Canel holds phone conversation with Xi Jinping



Havana, February 28 (RHC)--The President of the Republic, Miguel Díaz-Canel Bermúdez, held a cordial telephone conversation with the President and Secretary-General of the Central Committee of the Communist Party of China, Xi Jinping.

Díaz-Canel ratified to the Chinese leader the unwavering support and solidarity of the Cuban people, Party and government with that sister country in the battle to prevent and control the epidemic outbreak of the coronavirus.
