Siberia experiences recordbreaking heat wave, accelerating thawing of permafrost



New York, June 3 (RHC)-- In climate news, Siberia is experiencing a record-breaking heat wave. Some parts of the region registered temperatures more than 20 degrees higher than the historical average for this time of year.
