

Cuba detects three new cases of COVID-19 over the past 24 hours



Havana, June 23 (RHC)-- The National Director of Epidemiology of the Cuban Ministry of Public Health, Dr. Francisco Duran, reported that there were three new cases detected of COVID-19, for a total of 2,318 positive cases across the island.

During his daily press briefing held Tuesday morning, Dr. Duran said that over the past 24 hours -- up to 12 midnight Monday night -- fortunately, no patients died from the coronavirus. A total of 85 patients have died in Cuba over the past several months.

To date, 2,123 patients have recovered -- with 10 patients released from hospitalization during the day on Monday.
