
Cabrisas begins official visit to Venezuela to strengthen bilateral relations

Havana, January 29 (RHC) Cuban Deputy Prime Minister and the co-president of the Intergovernmental Commission of the Cuba-Venezuela Comprehensive Cooperation Agreement, Ricardo Cabrisas, is on an official visit to Venezuela.
