Brasilia, February 27 (RHC)-- A campaign in defense of the political rights of the former president of Brazil, Luiz Inácio Lula da Silva, was held on Saturday. The "Free Lula Working Group" was attended by former President Dilma Rousseff, former Foreign Minister Celso Amorim, Maranhão governor Flávio Dino, Joao Pedro Stédile, from the Landless Rural Workers Movement (MST) and the mayor of the French city of Paris, Anne Hidalgo, among others.

Also present were Jean Willis, lawyer Alberto Toron, attorney Gisele Cittadino, Pastora Romi, Paulo Galo of the anti-fascist couriers, Marco Aurélio Carvalho, of the Perrogativas group, and councilwoman Erika Hilton.

- * The challenges of a new justice system, with Governor Flávio Dino and lawyer Marco Aurélio Carvalho.
- * The need for a new Country project, with Paulo Galo, from the antifascist liberators, Pastora Romi and Erika Hilton.
