Havana, October 29 (RHC)-- The first secretary of the Central Committee of the Communist Party of Cuba (CC-PCC), Miguel Díaz Canel, paid tribute Friday to the historic leader of the Cuban Revolution, Fidel Castro Ruz, in front of the monolith that holds his ashes in the Santa Ifigenia cemetery in Santiago
