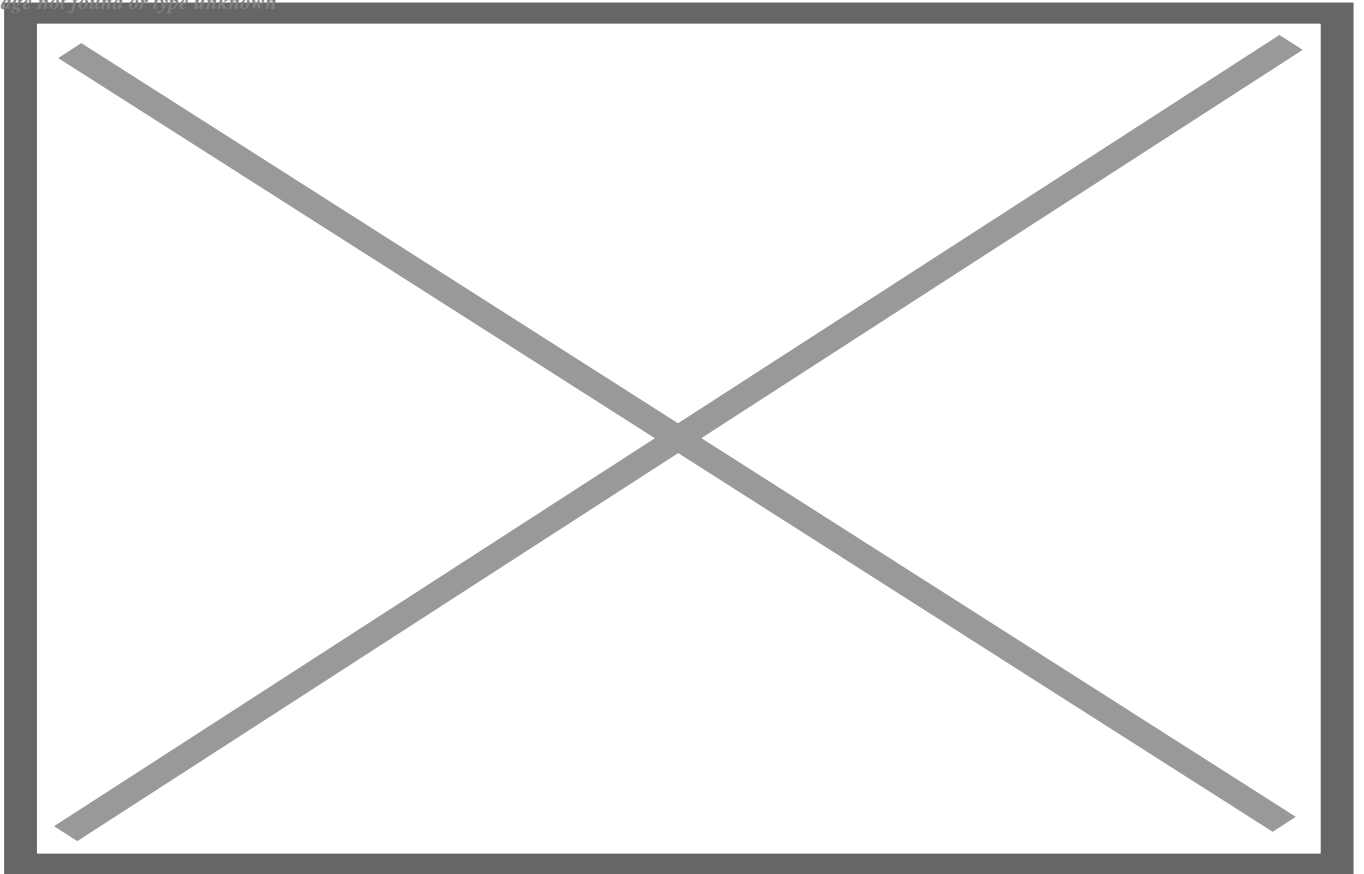


Cuba attends presidential inauguration in Angola

Angola's President, João Lourenço, was inaugurated in Luanda on Thursday for a second five-year term.

Luanda, September 15 (RHC)-- The Vice President of the Republic of Cuba, Salvador Valdés Mesa, attended Thursday's inauguration ceremony of Angola's reelected president, João Lourenço.
