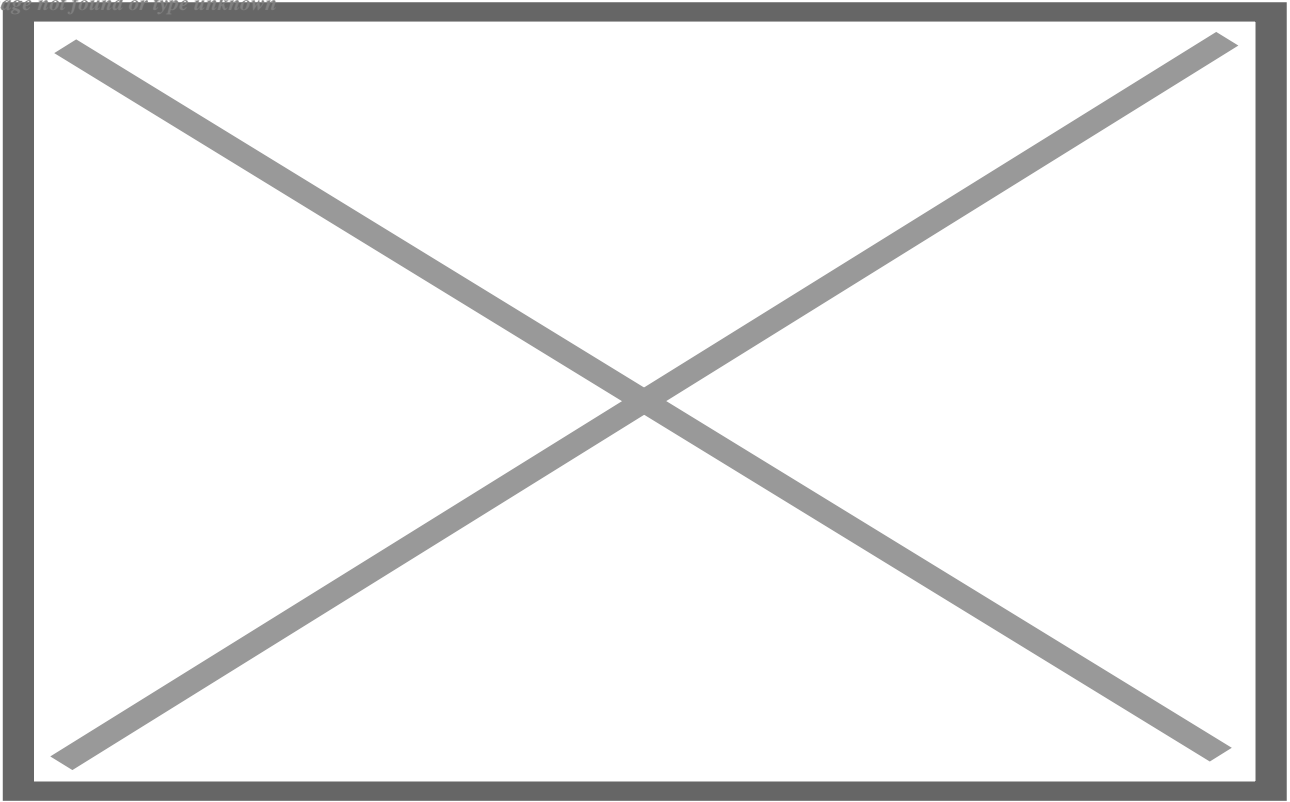


President of the UN General Assembly receives Cuban Foreign Minister Bruno Rodriguez

Havana, November 1 (RHC)-- The president of the United Nations General Assembly (UNGA), Hungarian Csaba Kőrösi received on Tuesday in New York, Cuban Foreign Minister Bruno Rodríguez with whom he held a meeting.

During the exchange, the foreign minister expressed Cuba's commitment to the defense of multilateralism, which has been one of the priorities of the president of the UNGA.

He also reaffirmed the willingness of our country to contribute to the deliberations of that body during Cuba's presidency at the head of the Group of 77 plus China, in 2023.

For his part, Csaba Kőrösi acknowledged the contribution of the largest Antillean island in the negotiating processes of the General Assembly.

The head of Cuban diplomacy is in New York to present for the thirtieth time, since 1992, the resolution "Need to put an end to the economic, commercial and financial blockade imposed by the United States of America against Cuba", on November 2 and 3.
