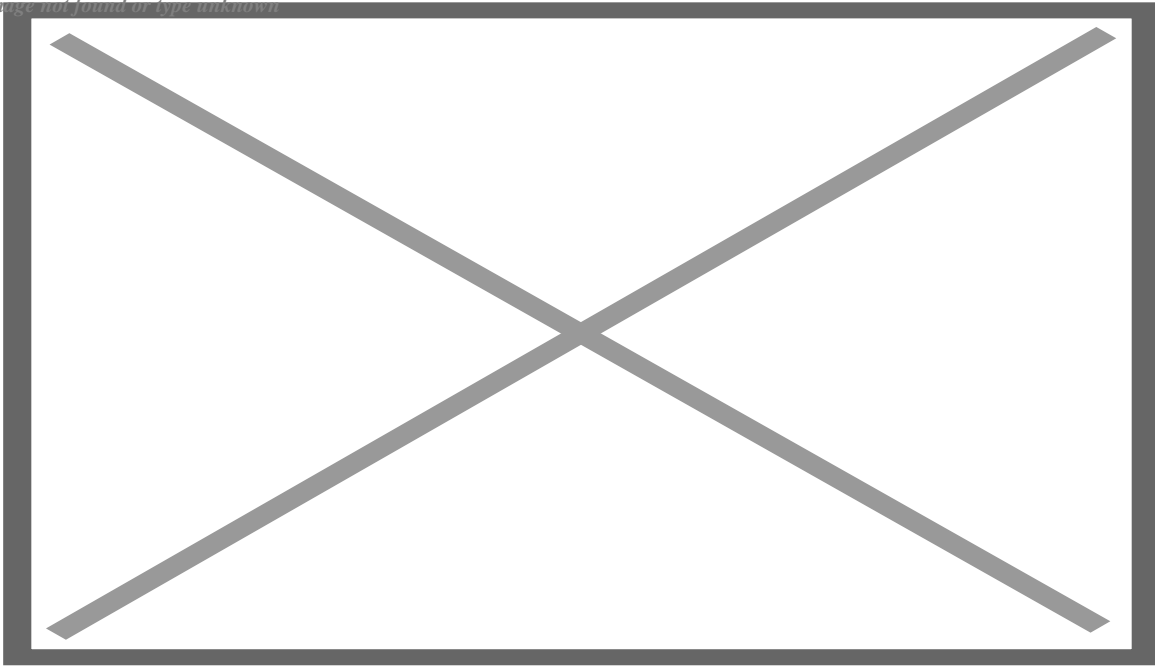


Three Cubans for titles in World Youth Boxing Championships

World Youth Boxing Championship

Havana, November 24 (JIT) - Cuba validated half of its attempts in the semifinals and will compete for three titles in the World Youth Boxing Championship of La Nucia 2022, in Spain.

The day left wins for Ewart Marín (51 kg), Ronny Álvarez (86 kg) and Adrián Fresneda (92 kg), and setbacks for Kryhztian Barrera (75 kg), Pedro Alexis Veitía (71 kg) and Luis Reynoso (80 kg), who will return home with bronze.

Marin disposed of Japan's Rui Yamaguchi 4-0, Alvarez took a 4-1 decision over Ireland's Osaro Ojo Natha and Fresneda knocked out Egypt's Abdelzahr Moham Khaled by RSC in the third act.

Uzbekistan was the "bête noire" of the slips, as that country provided the executioners of Barrera, Veitía and Reynoso: Turakeb Khabibullaev (5-0), Fazliddin Erkinboev (3-0) and Rakhmatullo Boymatov (5-0), in that order.

This Thursday will be a general rest. On Friday Alvarez will fight for gold against the Italian Paolo Caruso and one day later Marin will cross blows with the Mexican Ari Bonilla (MEX) and Fresneda will face the

English Damar Thomas.

Having three finalists puts the Island in a position to surpass the gold balance of the previous edition, held in the Polish city of Kielce, where only Jorge Luis Felimón (91 kg) was crowned and the harvest was completed with two bronze metals.
