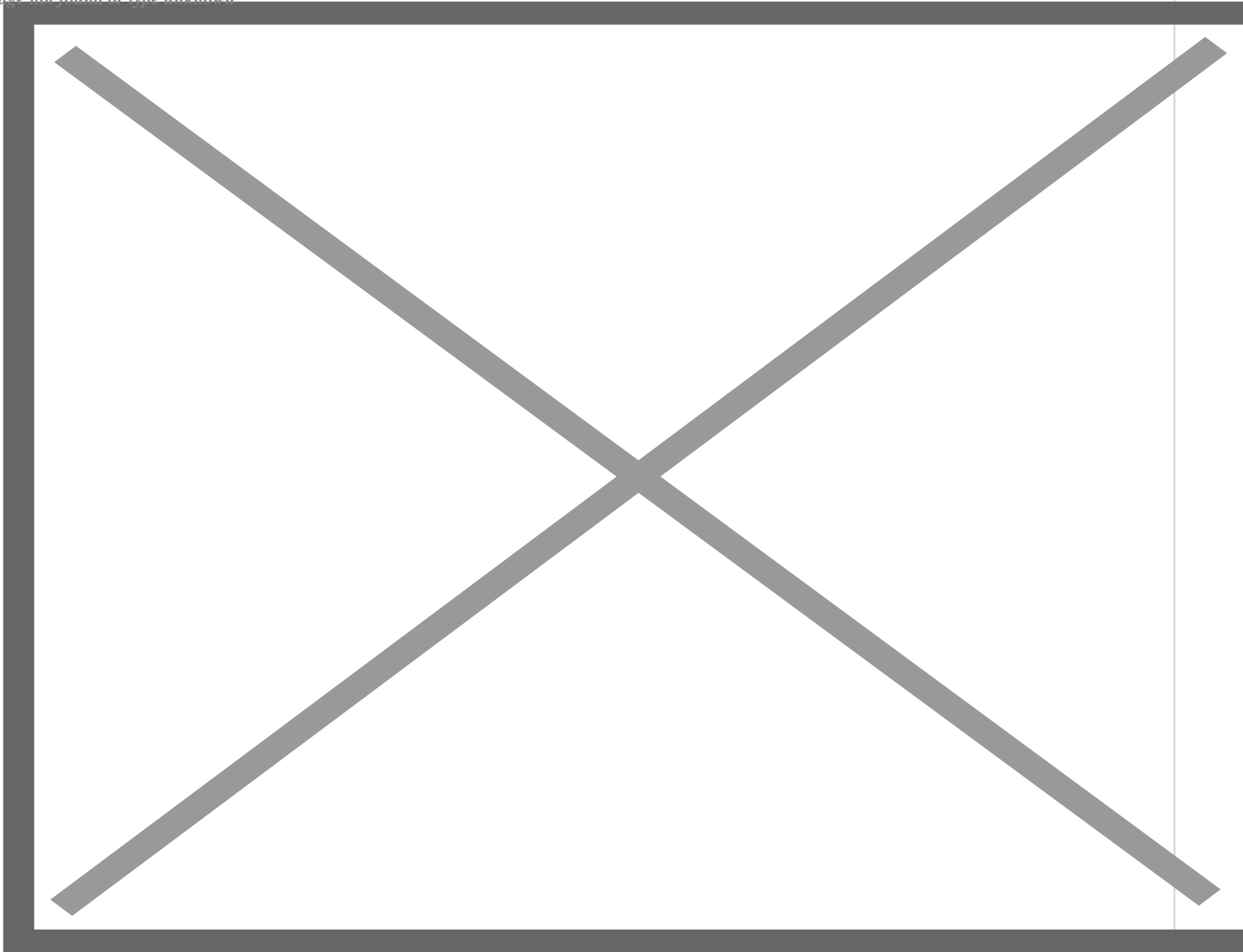


Cuba's foreign minister reaffirms his country's commitment to build socialism
