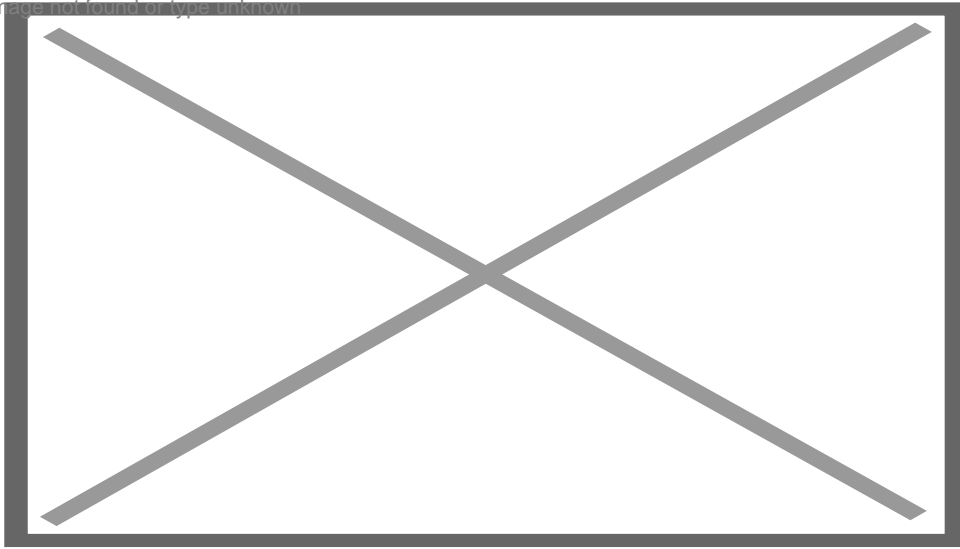


Cuban Foreign Minister Bruno Rodríguez
