Chess Tournament in tribute to Che

New Delhi, June 14 (RHC)-- The Solidarity Movement in India organized today in Andhra Pradesh a chess tournament in tribute to Ernesto Che Guevara and to ratify the rejection of the U.S. blockade against Cuba.

Numerous children who love the sport of strategy participated in the Che Guevara Memorial Chess Tournament, on the occasion of the celebrations for the 95th anniversary of the birth of the Argentinean-Cuban revolutionary guerrilla fighter.
