Havana, July 7 (RHC)-- The First Secretary of the Central Committee of the Communist Party of Cuba and President of the Republic, Miguel Díaz-Canel participated Friday in the conclusions of the Second Workshop on Agricultural Innovation, at the Cojímar Convention Center, in eastern Havana, with the attendance of at least 180 specialists from all provinces of the country.

Convened by the Directorate of Science, Technology, Innovation and Environment of the Ministry of Agriculture, the event, which has been in session since the day before, aims to disseminate the results of

research and the best experiences to strengthen agricultural production chains.
