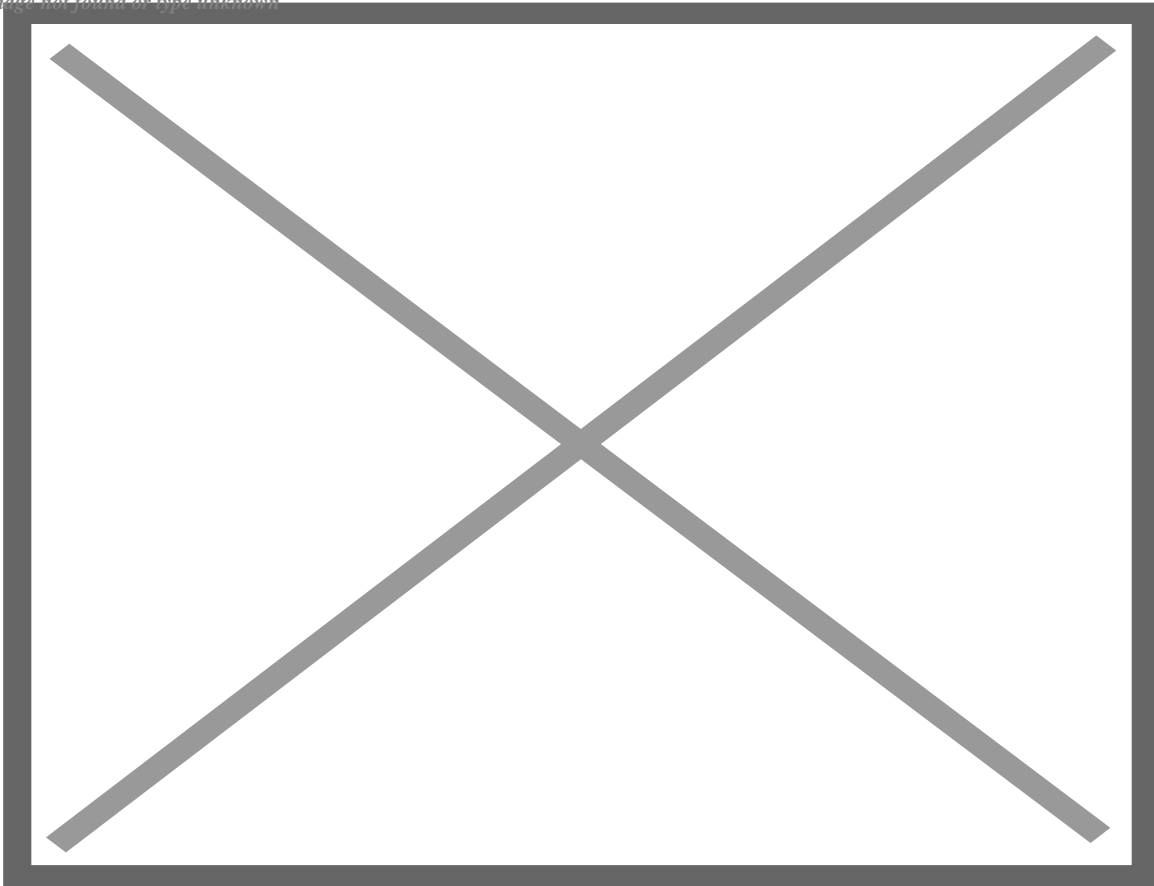


Cuba remembers Hugo Chavez on his birthday's anniversary
