
Cuban authorities congratulate Ivory Coast on the anniversary of its independence



Havana, Aug 7 (RHC) Cuban president Miguel Díaz-Canel sent a congratulatory message this Monday to his counterpart from the Republic of Ivory Coast, Alassane Dramane Ouattara, for the 63rd anniversary of the independence of that African country.

In addition to extending cordial greetings for the date, Díaz-Canel reiterated the will to strengthen the existing friendly relations between both nations.
