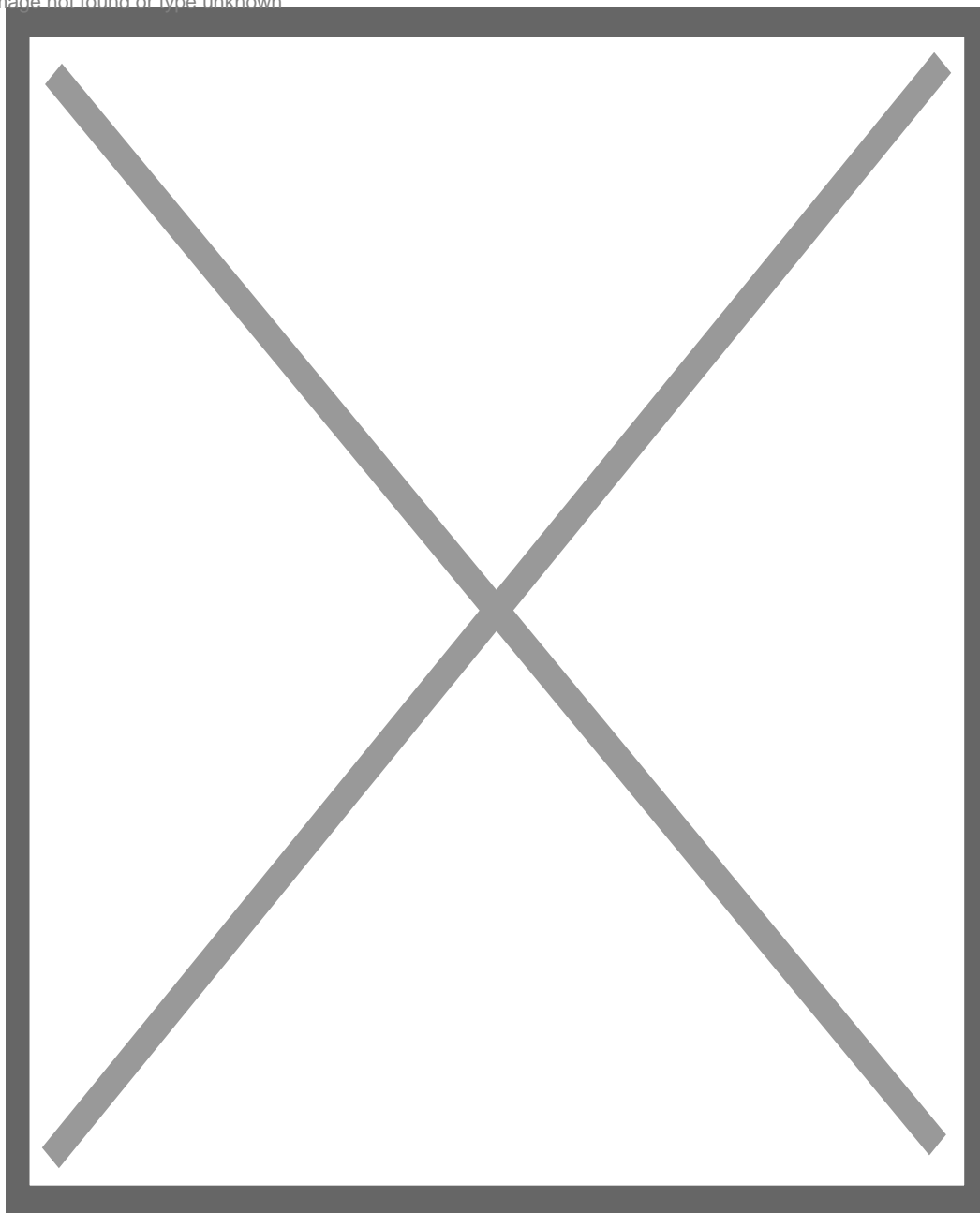


*Cuban president
