
Cuban Prime Minister receives leader of the Türkiye Parliament



Kurtulmu? reaffirmed that his country considers the largest island of the Antilles as an ally and a friend in Latin America and the Caribbean

Havana, May 9 (RHC) Cuban Prime Minister Manuel Marrero Cruz received this Wednesday the president of the Grand National Assembly of Türkiye, Numan Kurtulmu?, on an official visit to the Antillean nation.

Marrero expressed his interest in raising commercial ties to the same level as political ones, based on the areas of common interest that the parties have identified in recent years.
