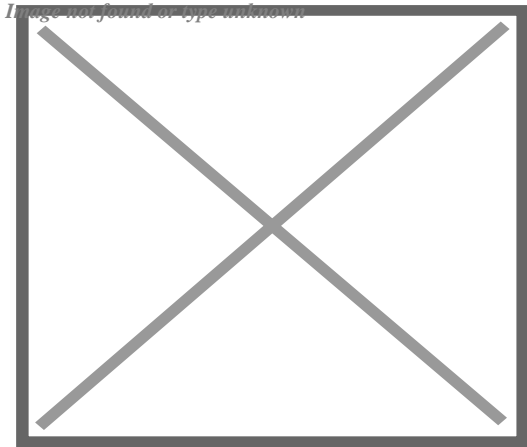


Goalless start at the Club World Cup

Club World Cup

Havana, Jun 15 (RHC) The kickoff of the FIFA Club World Cup 2025 in Miami left the fans in Miami wanting to shout "Goooooolll" after the 0-0 draw at the Hard Rock Stadium between Inter Miami and Egypt's Al Ahly.

The result at the start of the competition was undoubtedly due to the goalkeepers, it was their night: Oscar Ustari, for Inter, and Mohamed El Shenawy, for the African team, who put a stop to Leo Messi. No one could break the deadlock

The key point of the match came in the 43rd minute of the first half after a penalty kick by the African team was saved by the Argentine goalkeeper to keep the match scoreless. Inter Miami's captain had a chance in the 95th minute when he put in a tight cross that El Shenawy turned away, saving Al Ahly.

For Inter, it was a historic debut. The Club has just six since its foundation, while Al Ahly, from the Egyptian Premier League, is the winner of the CAF Champions League 2020-2021 and is the team with the most African titles in history.

Leo Messi's Inter Miami's next match will be against Porto (Portugal) on Thursday, June 19 at the Mercedes Benz Stadium in Atlanta, while the Egyptians will face Palmeiras (Brazil) at the MetLife in New Jersey on the same day.
