

Vietnamese Prime Minister Receives Cuban Communist Party Official

Ho Chi Minh City, May 2 (RHC) – Vietnamese Prime Minister Nguyen Tan Dung held talks on Friday with José Ramón Balaguer, member of the secretariat of the Central Committee of Cuba's Communist Party.

Balaguer was in Vietnam to attend celebrations for the 40th anniversary of Vietnamese Reunification and the end of the Vietnam War.

At the meeting, Nguyen highlighted the support provided by several countries to Vietnam during the war, pointing to the important role of Cuba.
