

Russia to Assist Cuba in Construction of Four Power Units, Steel Plant



Havana, June 26 (RHC) — Russia and Cuba are in the final stage of coordinating new energy and steel projects, according to Russian Ambassador to Cuba, Mikhail Kamynin.
