

Cuban President Raúl Castro Says U.S. Blockade is Cruel, Immoral and Illegal



Havana, September 19 (RHC)-- Cuban President Raul Castro personally welcomed Pope Francis at the José Martí International Airport in Havana Saturday afternoon. Addressing those present at the welcoming ceremony, the Cuban head of state pointed to tireless efforts by the Cuban government and people to build a truly just society with equity, despite the constant economic and political attacks against Cuba by its enemies.

The Cuban president said that the U.S. blockade against Cuba "is cruel, immoral and illegal."
