

Cuba Calls for 7th Summit of Association of Caribbean States in Havana

Petiónville, January 19 (RHC)-- Cuban Foreign Minister Bruno Rodríguez has called for the 7th Summit of Heads of State and/or Government of the Association of Caribbean States (ACS) to be held next June here in Havana.
