

Palestinian Minister of Foreign Affairs Thanks Cuba for Its Support



Havana, February 9 (RHC)-- Visiting Minister of Foreign Affairs of the Palestinian National Authority, Riad Al-Malki has thanked the Cuban government and people for their support of the Palestinian people's struggle for self-determination and independence.
