Cuban Minister of Agriculture to Lead Delegation to the United States



Havana, June 1 (RHC-PL) -- Cuban Minister of Agriculture, Gustavo Rodriguez, will lead a delegation which will visit the United States in response to the invitation made by his U.S. counterpart, Thomas Vilsack, the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Cuba announced Tuesday.
