

Cuba and Ethiopia Foreign Ministers Favor Strengthening Ties



Havana, Jun 11 (RHC-PL), -- Cuban Foreign Minister Bruno Rodriguez and his Ethiopian counterpart Tedros Adhanom Ghebreyesus favored Friday strengthening bilateral ties.
